Suring Sportsman's Club

Wednesday, April 28, 2021

1. The meeting was called to order and President Bill Madison read the minutes from March 31, 2021.
2. Old business: Pistol range is in good shape.
Decided that it was best to reschedule the post hole digging and pole setting until May when it's warmer outside.
The property owner behind the bow range had his property surveyed and we need to relocate the target frame and/or turn it and bring to back.
3. Rifle Range needs #1 berm to be either replaced or shored up. Need a forklift to get the job done because the sand has shifted over it. It was the last to be replaced, originally.
Will need a load of sand because bullets are putting grooves in it now.
One load of sand sound be enough.
The bow range needs to have the signs changed.
4. Treasurer's report was given by Don. (need validation of last name)
Motion to accept was made by Gary Hischke and seconded by Jay Tousey. Motion carried.
5. Fisherman's dock: dock extensions will be installed sometime in May. It's not handicapped accessible, but a bench will be present on the dock. The washstone has been updated and had to be pulled back a foot.
6. Looked at front berm – need to fix.
The west side of the range needs to have the orange fence installed, trimmed, and connected to the old fence. Will trim up nice to fit. Jay has enough to outfit the whole rifle range and attach it to the chain-link fencing. Have everything needed.
7. Want to replace the gate post with a better one.
Date for post installation for new fence:
Afternoons preferred – scheduled for Wednesday, May 5, 2021 earlier in the afternoon.
Those who arrive early may do necessary brush clearing/cutting, lay out chalk line for posts, etc.

8. The building and everything else is in good shape.
Need to clean up the brush and find something to pull the ammo sweeper behind it because the mower doesn't have any way to hook it up behind it.

9. Gary Hischke retired from mowing the grass at the SSC.
Jay thanked Gary for the wonderful job he's done with the grounds, etc. Gary said he'll show whoever wants to learn how to operate the mower, etc.
The lawn mower shed needs to be tended to (aka cleaned, straightened up, etc.)

10. Want to look into ways of controlling the run-off of storm water and need to empty the porta-potty.

11. The Breed Sportsman's Club is having a bike raffle.
A motion was made by Gary Hischke for the Suring Sportsman's Club to give \$80.00 for the bike raffle.
