

MINUTES Suring Sportsman's Club Wednesday, May 26, 2021

The meeting was called to order and President Bill Madison read the minutes from April 28, 2021.
 Bill called for a motion to accept the minutes. A motion was made by Ken and seconded by Jay Tousey. Motion carried.

2. Old business:

- The fence along the rile range has been completely installed and finished.
- The pistol range needs the brush trimmed, etc.
- Bow range: need to find out who's responsible for liability insurance and permissions.
- Rifle range needs orange fence put around it. Jay said we have enough to get it done.
- Berm #1 still needs a pole -back one. It still needs sand to shore it up. It seems to be water washed. Thinking about taking bids to put the new beam in because we're a little shorthanded.
- Need a post for the bow range sign. Jay will check on getting a post. Gary still has the post hole digger.

3. New Business:

- Youth Day is the first Saturday in August (August 7, 2021). We need to get the info out for that and call Trout Unlimited to order the rainbow trout. Jay Tousey said he'll get it done.
- We're sponsoring the Sportsman Alliance this year on July 8, 2021, at the Town of How Community Center at 6:30 PM. Beer, water, and soda only. We have to provide snacks. They charged us just to rent provided we do our own setup, takedown, and sweeping.
- The Labor Day Parade Association has asked for a donation to help provide for more prizes for the 2021 Parade. There will be 5 categories each awarding 1st, 2nd, and 3rd prizes. Ken made a motion to give \$100 to the Labor Parade Association for prizes and Don seconded the motion. Motion carried.
- 4. The treasurer's report was given by Don Trester.

 Bill called for a motion to accept the treasurer's report; Jay made the motion to accept, and Ken seconded the motion. Motion carried.
- 5. Discussed donating for the Labor Day Demolition Derby. Jay motioned to donate the same amount as in 2020, which was \$200. Don seconded the motion. Motion carried.

- 7. We'll need at least 6 people present for the cash raffle drawing(s), including the Treasurer, Secretary, and a few other people.
 - We also need 30 envelopes and stamps, pens, and a memo sheet for the daily numbers drawn.
 - We need 30 checks, one for each day in June with the amount of \$100.
- 8. We need to set up a date to put up the orange fence, pig rings, and wire; and clean up the unused wood by the shed.
- 9. The front fence needs to be put up before the Youth Outing.
