



MINUTES
Suring Sportsman's Club
Wednesday, January 28, 2026

1. The meeting was called to order by President Josh Arndt.

- The flag needs to be repaired sometime this spring and our Spring cleanup day is to be determined.

- We need a new location to put/store the deer hides for donation. The club has learned that the hides were mistakenly thrown into the trash dumpster and were disposed of.
