



**MINUTES**  
**Suring Sportsman's Club**  
**Wednesday, March 25, 2026**

1. The meeting was called to order by President Josh Arndt.
  
2. Josh A. called for the minutes of the February 25, 2026, meeting to be read. Leigh Dudenhoeffer read the minutes. Josh A. called for a motion to accept the minutes as read. Jay Tousey made the motion and Kurt Bruegl seconded the motion. The motion carried.
  
3. Josh A. called for the Treasurer's report to be read. Kurt Bruegl read the treasurer's report. Josh called for a motion to accept the treasurer's report as read. Mark Zahn moved and Tony Gauthier seconded. The motion carried.
  
4. Old Business:
  - Kurt gave the banquet report. He stated that this banquet was the best ever and that he received many great reports from attendees.
  
  - Josh A. noted that the 501 c3 / c7 still needs to be checked into, therefore the bylaws remain tabled until we have more information.
  
  - The Spring cleanup day is Saturday, May 9, 2026. It will start at 8:30 a.m. We'll be cleaning all of the brush away from all of our buildings. Please wear appropriate work cloths and bring tools and gloves.
  
5. New Business:
  - The rifle range 25 yard post needs to be replaced as it's rotted. We may have to remove it and push everything back. The poles are leaning/slanted. We also might need a wider swale on the berms.
  
  - The roof of the clubhouse needs to be replaced as it's well over 20 years old and the shingles are cupping on the North side. We need to get 3 or 4 estimates/quotes.
  
  - We discussed our annual donations and unanimously agreed to increase the donation to both Oconto County Sportsman's Alliance and the Trout Unlimited Annual Banquet by \$100, making them each \$200 annually. Our donation of \$1000 to the SMAC Fishery program will be an annual donation.
  
  - We discussed the scholarship that we offer to students who are pursuing a career in the fields of Conservation, Natural Resources, Forestry, Wildlife Management, or Environmental studies. Gary Hischke made a motion to grant the \$1000 in one lump sum instead of splitting it into \$500 payments paid over the

first 2 years. Jay T seconded and the motion carried.

- We've noted that no one has applied this year and discussed rolling it over into an interest bearing CD if no one applies for it. The money and interest would be granted to chosen applicants who apply for it next year, and/or thereafter. Mark Zahn made the motion to do so, if no one applies, and give the next year's applicant(s) the whole thing. Tony Gauthier seconded the motion and the motion carried. The Scholarship Qualifying Criteria will be amended to reflect these changes for next year.

7. Josh A. called for a motion to adjourn the meeting. Kurt Bruegl moved and Tony G. seconded. The motion carried.
