



MINUTES

1. The meeting was called to order by President Josh Arndt at 6:30 P.M.

4. Old Business:
 - The 501 c3/c7: In order to continue with the process, we need to adopt the new bylaws. We will do the 3rd reading at the of the bylaws at the May 27th meeting so they can be adopted. Once the bylaws are adopted, we can proceed with the non-profit process.

 - We've received 2 quotes for replacing the current clubhouse roof with a new steel roof. After reviewing the 2 quotes, a motion was made by Gary Hischke and seconded by Bill M to approve the quote from Henry School for a total of \$5,698.00. After more discussion, a motion was made by Chad P. and seconded by Bill M. to budget a total of \$7,000.00 to allow for any unforeseen issues that may come up during the project.

 - The Spring cleanup day is Saturday, May 9, 2026, at 8:30 a.m. Mark Z has confirmed that a number of students from the trap club will be helping out. Poles and steel for the pistol range are on site and Josh will be obtaining the rest of the lumber prior to the 9th. ***Please wear appropriate work cloths and bring tools and gloves.***

5. New Business:
 - The annual Youth Outdoor Fun Day is scheduled for Saturday, August 1, 2026. Bill M. has everything in the works. Jim Fonferok will donate 5 lbs. of hotdogs and several boxes of .22 shells for youth day. We will follow up with more discussion at the May meeting.

 - The Sausage Shoot will be held on Saturday, June 27, 2026, at the club. The start time is 9:00 A.M. Jay is coordinating it. We'll follow up at the May meeting.

 - A motion was made by Gary H. and seconded by Jay T. to increase the lawn mowing compensation from \$50 per session to \$75 per session. The motion carried.

- The president of the Wisconsin State Senate will be speaking with the local chapter of Trout Unlimited in regard to the operation of the fish hatchery near Lakewood. No decision was made at this time and further discussion was tabled until our next meeting.
